DIGITAL PSAT Wednesday, October 23

The digital PSAT is a practice SAT test, but also serves as a qualifying test for the **National Merit Scholars Program**. Students will no longer be testing with pencil and paper; instead they will use their school-issued laptops. The test will last approximately 2 hours and 15 minutes and students will use an application called Bluebook. All juniors have been introduced to Bluebook and can take a full or mini-practice test.

ACTION:

There has been a critical update for Bluebook since the last time they have accessed it. All juniors must take the following actions:

- **Restart computer and then open the Bluebook app (no need to sign in)**
- This will automatically update Bluebook and they will be able to test

What to Bring on PSAT/NMSQT Test Day:

- FULLY CHARGED LAPTOP
- While we cannot guarantee you'll have access to an outlet during testing bring your POWER CORD
- YOUR FULLY CHARGED device should be able to hold a charge for 3–4 hours
- Pencil or Pen - for scratchwork
- Scratch paper **will be provided**—do not bring your own
- An approved calculator; a graphing calculator built into the app, but you can bring your own if you like
- External mouse (optional)
- Sweatshirt/jacket
- Snack
- Please arrive by 7:55am; testing will begin promptly at 8am. **Late arrivals may not be able to test.**
