

UMSL ACP Registration Fall 2022 and Yearlong Courses

UMSL's Advanced Credit Program offers qualifying, high-caliber high school students in select schools the opportunity to earn college credits and become familiar with the college experience while still in a high school setting. All courses are taught at Nerinx by Nerinx faculty.

Cost:

UMSL charges \$70/credit hour

Eligibility to Participate:

High School Juniors and Seniors - minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 unweighted scale; students with a 2.5-2.99 are also eligible with approval from their principal and/or guidance counselor as well as permission from a parent or legal guardian

Sophomores - minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 unweighted scale (no exceptions)

Freshman - minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 unweighted scale (no exceptions); have scored in the 90th percentile or above composite score on your most recent standardized test

- A Google, Yahoo, or Facebook account is required for each student
- When finished applying, parents will be sent an email allowing them to electronically approve their student
 - Parent approval is due by the close of registration
 - Please enter correct email addresses or we may not be able to process your application
 - Registration is not complete until students register and parents approve the registration
- After parent approval, Nerinx will approve the student's enrollment
