Hello Sophomore Parents,

We recently met with your daughter to briefly talk about college but more importantly, get them logged onto SCOIR. **SCOIR** is a one-stop online platform that provides students with college and career planning tools to use during their time at Nerinx.

What can sophomores do on SCOIR?

- Record activities and achievements such as clubs, service info, awards, sports, etc; it is never too early to start this and to be ready for applications senior year
- Use the college database to explore and begin to learn about various colleges
- Use the college search function to put in criteria and receive a list of schools that meet the criteria
- Begin a list of potential schools (also called “following” list)
- Begin to think about college preferences (big/little, close/far, etc) and notate in SCOIR
- Sign up to meet with College Reps at Nerinx; sophomores are encouraged to visit with college reps during activity period; a list of schools coming is on SCOIR; questions to ask a rep - [click here](#)

Can parents access SCOIR?

Parents will be sent an email with registration details, or, students can invite parents through their account. Parents can use SCOIR to explore colleges and even suggest schools to their daughter.
